2022 – 2023 Updated Information on Tests

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SAT Changes

- The College Board discontinued the essay portion of the SAT® Test, and it is no longer available.
- Beginning in 2023, the SAT will be given digitally online. It will still occur at schools, with a proctor.
- Test questions will remain somewhat the same, but the way students take the test will be different.
- In 2023, the SAT will be a "Computer Adaptive Testing" and questions will be tailored to the student, based on their answers to each previous question.

PSAT Changes

- The PSAT/NMSQT® and PSAT 8/9 will be given digitally online in 2023
- The PSAT 10 will be digital and online in 2024.

SAT Subject Tests

- The College Board has discontinued SAT Subject Tests® and they are no longer available.
- Subject tests are only available through AP Tests, CLEP Tests, or DSST Tests.

CLT Tests

- The CLT Test is an alternative to SAT or ACT, however, there are over 5000 colleges and universities in the United States, and the CLT is currently accepted by about 200 of them.
- Because of its classical liberal arts emphasis, and content free from Common Core, the popularity of this test is growing, especially among homeschoolers.

CLEP Tests

 These tests may be free to you, depending on your state, through Modern States Education Alliance.
